

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Town and City of Batavia has announced that a public informational meeting will be held to discuss the proposed preliminary design of the Ellicott Trail. The meeting will be held on June 3, 2015 at Batavia City Hall, 1 Batavia City Centre, at 7:00 P.M.

The Town and City of Batavia are developing preliminary design studies for the Ellicott Trail. This locally administered federal aid project (PIN 4760.79) in Genesee County begins at Pearl Street NYS 33 (western terminus) in the City of Batavia, and extends easterly approximately 4.6 miles via on and off street segments to its eastern terminus at Seven Springs Road in the Town of Batavia.

The purpose of the meeting is to obtain comments on the proposed project from individuals, groups, officials and local agencies. The Town and City of Batavia are soliciting comments on the development of alternates for the project and comments on the project's social, economic and environmental effects. This public informational meeting is part of the continuing efforts by the Town and City of Batavia to encourage public input into the development of transportation projects.
