**PURCHASE USED GRADER FOR  
HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS,** the Highway Superintendent recommends replacing the Town's 1966 Austin Western grader with a newer used grader purchased at auction, and

**WHEREAS,** the State of New York Department of Transportation has a Used 1986 John Deere 670B Grader which is being sold at their September 21, 2016 surplus equipment auction and the Highway Superintendent recommends purchasing the grader at a price not to exceed \$25,000, and

**WHEREAS,** if the used grader is purchased at the New York State auction the Highway Superintendent recommends selling the Town's current 1966 Austin Western grader at auction at a later date.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT**

**RESOLVED,** the Batavia Town Board hereby authorizes the Highway Superintendent to purchase the Used 1986 John Deere 670B Grader at the New York State Equipment Surplus auction at an amount not to exceed \$25,000, and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED,** if the New York State grader is purchased the highway superintendent is authorized to sell the Town's current 1966 grader at auction at a later date, and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED,** the expenditure will be appropriated from line item DA5130.200.
