RE: CH4 BIOGAS-AG PARK- AREA VARIANCE

Chairman Gary Diegelman called the public hearing to order at 6:55 PM. The notice, as published in the Batavia News was read by the Chairman. The purpose of the public hearing is to obtain approval for an area variance for height of 6 proposed tanks.

Gary Diegelman explained that they are looking for a height variance for the following tanks:

1. 81' Digester
2. 50' (3) Pasteurization Tanks
3. 55' Storage Tank
4. 50' Tank

The town ordinance allows height of 40'. Mr. Diegelman stated the rest of the tanks in or around Ag Park are 120' at Mueller, 146' Oatka Milk & 110' Partridge Farm Wind Towers.

Gary Diegelman opened the public hearing to any questions the residents may have.

County Planning did not respond to area variance request.


When no further comments or opinions were expressed, the public hearing was closed at 7:01pm.
